

Middle Tennessee TRC Course

Announcing the arrangements for a Trike Rider's Course (TRC), to be conducted in the middle Tennessee area, at Smyrna, TN on Saturday, March 31. The classroom portion of the course will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m., with a lunch break, immediately followed by the range exercises.

Where: Highland Heights Church of Christ, Annex and Parking Lot, 785 S. Lowry St, Smyrna, TN 37167

Driving Directions:

From Murfreesboro: Proceed North on Hwy 41/70S (North Broad Street) toward Smyrna. As you enter the city limits of Smyrna the Church is located on your right, after passing under Nissan Blvd/Lee Victory Parkway.

From Interstate 24: Take Exit 70, Hwy 102, East toward Smyrna. Follow the sign to Smyrna as you approach the first exit ramp. After exiting the ramp, you will be proceeding North into Smyrna. The church is on your immediate right after passing under Nissan Blvd/Lee Victory Parkway.

From Points North of Smyrna: Take Hwy 41/70S South from Antioch/LaVergne and proceed into Smyrna. You will pass through the majority of the town of Smyrna. The church is on your left, just before leaving the city limits of Smyrna, and just prior to the underpass at Nissan Blvd/Lee Victory Parkway.

When: March 31, 2012. Class administrative requirements and instruction, begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. Range Exercises, immediately following lunch (students should be prepared to depart at approximately 3:00 p.m.)

Cost: \$50.00 per bike, one-up or two-up. Advance registration is required, and class fees must be received not later than March 24. Payment may be in the form of cash or check made payable to Appalachian Region N.

Motorcycle operators will be required to produce a current GWRRR membership card, proof of a valid Motorcycle Operators Permit and proof of insurance at the beginning of the class.

Lunch: A one hour lunch break will be provided upon completion of classroom instruction. Participants may want to brown bag their lunch, or fast food facilities such as Subway, Hardees, McDonalds, Wendy's, Sonic, Arby's, Pizza Hut, etc., are readily available. Participants in the range exercise should be prepared to take no longer than an hour for lunch. Restroom facilities are available on site.
