

Shirley Burton Memorial  
Spirit Award  
Guidelines

This Award will be presented at the Winter Event each year to the Tennessee Chapter who has shown the most Spirit for the previous year. This Award is NOT for how much your Chapter accomplished or how many trophies your Chapter won. It IS for how much PARTICIPATION, ENTHUSIASM & FUN your Chapter has shown throughout the year. Shirley Burton exemplified PARTICIPATION & ENTHUSIASM in having FUN. These three elements are what makes the SPIRIT we have in Tennessee GWRRA. This is why we honor her memory with this Award.

These are the Guidelines to follow:

- Each Chapter wishing to be considered must submit a typed write-up no more than one (1) page stating:
  - (1) How much FUN your Chapter has had this year.
  - (2) How much ENTHUSIASM your Chapter has shown.
  - (3) How well your Chapter has PARTICIPATED in the fun.
- A Member, with Membership Fees paid in full, must write write-up.
- Member producing the Write-up must be on the Chapter Roster and a regular participant of the Chapter being nominated.
- Write-up must bear the Nominator and Chapter Directors signatures.  
(Assistant Chapter Director can sign in the place of the CD if needed)
- The write-up must be received no later than December 31, 2009.

The District Staff will select the winning Chapter from the write-up entries. The decision will NOT be based on how well a write-up is written, but WILL be based on facts and contents of the write-up.
